

Existing employment services are ineffective in supporting vulnerable women into work. These women remain locked out of the workforce, languishing on government benefits, in poverty and trapped in cycles of disadvantage.

These women include those who have experienced family and domestic violence (92%), incarceration, addiction, trauma, mental ill health, are veterans, culturally and linguistically diverse (12%), Indigenous (14%), single mothers (56%), and are socially isolated (50%).

OUR SOLUTION: INCLUSIVE WORK PROGRAM

Our tailored program reduces personal and systemic barriers and creates pathways of employment.

Our 9-week program successfully:

- Improves wellbeing
- Teaches modern workskills
- Provides real experiences of modern workplaces
- Advocates to resolve health, housing, legal, financial, safety or other systemic barriers to employment
- Removes social isolation by building community, friendship and belonging
- Secures suitable and sustainable employment including long-term work, bridging employment or study
- Provides ongoing care to maintain employment and social well-being





WHAT WE HAVE ACHIEVED

We have supported 60 women through our program since April 2021 with lifechanging impact for these women and their children.
